- Review Comprehensive Assessment
- Review CT Case Plan, notes etc.
- Initial Meeting client and/or family

Relationship Building

- Beneficial Conversations, trust building etc.
- Review CT Case Plan together
- Establish goals and commitment
- Agree upon a mentoring plan, including schedule

Client Responsibilities

- Honest
- Open
- Transparent
- Enthusiastic participation

Successful completion

- CT Case plan completed
- Mentoring plan achieved
- Goals achieved
- Exit Plan with goals

Relationship Termination

- Zero Tolerance policy:
 - Violence, physical or verbal
 - Dishonesty
- Time out-- agreed upon length
- Lack of heart:
 - Unwillingness to succeed
- Personality Conflicts
 - Mentor change

RoadMap Self Directed

Contact Point- RoadMap to Self Sufficiency orientation

- Review Comprehensive Assessment
- Goals agreed upon
- CT Case Plan established
- Check in date established, entered in CT RoadMap
- RoadMap literature provided to client
